Leslie Briggs Coombs Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Leslie Briggs Coombs who taught at Harvard University and was the first President of Durfee Tech; now the University of Massachusetts in Dartmouth. The \$1000 award is presented to a student who is an all-around good scholar and athlete in need of financial support.

Ruth Coombs Bogle Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is offered in memory of Ruth Coombs Bogle who was a first grade teacher for twenty five years. She was also a major contributor to increasing Christian education at the United Congregational Church. The \$1000 award is presented to a student who plans to pursue a degree in education.

Note: In the event that there are no applicants who plan to pursue a degree in education, the scholarship will be awarded to an applicant with plans to pursue a degree in an alternate field.

Doris E. Simmons Memorial Educational Scholarship

Doris E. Simmons was a lifelong resident of Little Compton, RI, an educator, and a member of the Little Compton School Committee. In her Last Will and Testament, she bequeathed "to the School Committee of Little Compton, Rhode Island a sum of money (amount omitted) to be known as the DORIS E. SIMMONS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP. This sum shall be deposited in a savings bank account as decided upon by the School Committee and each year the interest only from this fund shall be given to some Little Compton student in the senior class of the high school they are attending who in the sole discretion of the said School Committee is deserving of this scholarship help for their post high school education."

James Webster Coombs Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of James Webster Coombs who was a former Little Compton School Superintendent. The award amount is \$1000.00. The recipient needs to demonstrate leadership characteristics and school/community support. Additional criteria should include leadership in school and the community activities (athletics, music, the arts). The individual should demonstrate scholastic achievements, though it is not necessary to be a straight-A student or to be placed on the honor-roll.

Anthony Raposa Education Trust Scholarship

The Town of Little Compton School District was named a remainder beneficiary under the Raposa Education Trust. The intent of the Trust is to provide funds for "... the furtherance of the higher education of students who graduate from public or private high schools in the area encompassing the City of Fall River, Little Compton, Seekonk, Somerset, Swansea, Rehoboth, Tiverton, and Westport." The Little Compton Scholarship will be administered and awarded to a Little Compton student by the Little Compton School Committee.

The Trust further states, "The recipients shall be students who show promise of being able to benefit from college instruction or technical or vocational school instruction. In making the selections, the following criteria shall be important:

- 1. good character,
- 2. need, and

3. recommendation from the principal of his or her high school"
